The Special Meeting for the Moore Township Board of Supervisors (BOS) was called to order on Tuesday, September 28, 2021, by Chairman Daniel Piorkowski at 5:00 PM. The meeting was conducted at the municipal building. Members present were Chairman Daniel Piorkowski, Vice Chairman David Shaffer, Supervisor Richard Gable, Township Manager Nicholas Steiner, and Chief Gary West.

RESOLUTION 2021-12 LSA Grant Application Police Vehicles

Mr. Steiner explained the LSA program requires the Board to pass a resolution allowing Mr. Steiner to apply for LSA grants. They can apply to both the Northampton-Lehigh Counties grand and Monroe County grant. If they don't get one, they can see if they'll get the other. They are applying for funding for two police Explorers similar to the one purchased earlier this year. This includes the upfitting of the new WatchGuard cameras. The total cost would be \$106,522 based on quotes from Koch 33 and WatchGuard. If they have any other minor upfitting including mobile printers and scanners, they will purchase through normal budgetary funds as they were unable to get quotes in time. These vehicles will replace the two Dodge Chargers. One is missing a cylinder, and the other is also in the shop with issues. Chief West said it's still drivable, but he doesn't know if it will make it another year.
